



Training on Preparation for PSC Inspections and Recommendations to Avoid Most Common Detainable Deficiencies

Course Objectives

PSC aims, through a system of harmonized inspections to ensure compliance with international regulations and to abolish substandard ships. Taking into consideration that only Internationally Accepted Conventions shall be enforced during PSC inspections, the course focuses on the field implementation of this legislation.

The basic topics to be analyzed are:

- Introduction to PSC Inspections
- Procedures for PSC
- Observations during PSC Inspections
- Examination of ISM / ISPS / MLC Codes; Implementation during PSC Inspections
- Paris MoU - New Inspection Regime (NIR)
- PSC Findings

Emphasis will be given on:

- ✓ Why so much focus on PSC?
- ✓ Detained ships are made public on web sites and in the press
- ✓ Multiple detentions will have severe negative impact on the ability of a ship and its Company to trade
- ✓ Financial consequences
- ✓ Potential criminal prosecution for violations
